The Welcome Swallow Gallery extremely proud to present its second exhibition, A Journey With Chinese Art that is inspired by Chinese history and traditions. Throughout Chinese history, the practice of art is first learned by rote, in which the master shows the "right way" to draw. Generations of new artists are encouraged to demonstrate mastery continuous brush strokes movement until it becomes instinctive.

However, in contemporary times, debates have established the limits of this tradition. Within modern art scenes, innovation is now more the rule. As with Western traditions, changing lifestyles, tools, and colors are also influenced by new waves of Chinese master painters.

Yong Ming Liu is a consummate artist in the traditional Chinese landscape style. His sublime scrolls that featured in our last exhibition were sold to European collectors and throughout New Zealand. The current exhibition boasts four more of his scrolls together with a special intriguing Chinese perspective on the New Zealand landscape at Lake Taupo.

Using a mixture of the claborate style supplemented with innovative techniques, **Jing Liu**, shows considerable artistic dexterity in presenting several paintings that dynamically capture New Zealand flora, birds and delicately painted insects. Additionally, she presents two beautifully painted fans that both tell stories. Represented in Chinese art as one of the four 'noble

gentlemen', The plum tree's blossom featured in one of the fans, (No. 15 in the Catalogue), is seen as a symbol of winter ending and the heralding of spring. The tree's pale pink blossoms are cherished because they bloom vibrantly and so bravely amidst the winter chill.

this exhibition also we are showcasing Chinese calligraphy. This is the stylized artistic writing of Chinese characters, the written form of Chinese that unites the spoken languages. Such calligraphy is considered supreme among the visual arts in China, setting the standard by which Chinese painting is judged. Yu Ting Li demonstrates her mastery of this art with several representations of Chinese calligraphy, with three forms of the Heart Sutra that was developed in China some 600 years ago from original Sanskrits.

Li's calligraphic form and content embodies the notion of the emptiness of lived experiences and compassion as being dialectically related. Accordingly, these works point the art of calligraphy towards the heart of cultural discourse and matters of philosophical debate regarding the human condition. There can be no greater narrative than this: A Chinese The Journey With Art. exhibition is designed to provide an immersive experience that challenges, informs and delights.










